Agenda-2. For extension of affiliation for the year 2023-24/permanent affiliation, LIC were carried out for IITE affiliated 09 DIET colleges on 21/01/2023 and 27/01/2023 through online mode. The Chairman of the said LIC committees submitted the reports. The recommendations of these reports are mentioned below.

Resolution-4 The Council decided to approve the minutes of the Board of Social Sciences and Pedagogy of Social Sciences and to implement the syllabus of Pedagogy of Teaching Method- 1 Agronomy from the academic year 2022-23. Agenda-5. To provide the details of Ms. Hitaishi Bhatt (PRN: 211060030038) student of District Institute of Teacher Education, Bhavnagar case and decision of University in her case, as per the provisions of the Regulation and Ordinance.

Above student didn't completed necessary Practical Work required for Term-Grant during her Study of Semester-1 so she was not eligible to appear in

University Examination of Semester-1 and as per the IITE Ordinance she was also not eligible for admission to 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester and University Examination of Semester-2 and 3 so after giving her a chance for representation along with her College Representatives and taking into consideration related documents, University decided to Quash her results as per the provisions of IITE Regulation 29(9)(C).

Resolution-5 Following facts were presented to the members:

A Student of DIET, Bhavnagar Ms. Hitaishi Bhatt (PRN: 211060030038) took admission to B.Ed. Course and during her Semester-1, she had not completed required practical work like Micro Teaching and Simulation and as per the IITE Regulation 29-B student requires 80% attendance in Theory and 90% attendance in Practical to appear in the Semester End Examination and for the grant of the term but in her case as her practical work was not completed required attendance was not there and due to that she was not eligible to appear in Semester End Examination Semester-1 and also not eligible to get admission in next Semester as per the provision of IITE Ordinance 23-2 but in her case college mark her eligible to take the examination of Semester-1 without considering the provisions of Regulation and Ordinance. As College granted her term for the Semester-1 student was promoted to Semester-2 and 3 respectively and also she was marked eligible to take the Semester End Examination of Semester-2 and 3.

As she was not eligible to take the Semester End Examination of Semester-1 and to get admission in further semesters, the committee formed by University twice gave her a chance to represent her case in Month of January and February 2023 along with her College faculties and based on that University decided to quash her result of Semester-1, 2 and 3 and canceled her admission in Semester-4 and informed the same to her and concerned college with the letter dated 21-02-2023.

The matter was discussed deliberately and noted the main negligence from college side. The council took the following decisions in this matter as a special case and specific to this case only.

1. To allow the student to continue her study in Semester-4 and revoke the decision to cancel her result of Semester-1 and 2 took based on provisions of Regulation 29(9)(C) as her term for the Semester-1, 2 and 3 was granted by the College and she also appeared in the examination of all those semesters.
2. To consider the practical work of Semester-1 carried out by her during Semester-2 and based on that process and declare her result of Semester-1 (ATKT) and also declare the result of Semester-3
3. To calculate her attendance to decide the eligibility to appear in Semester End Examination of Semester-4 excluding the period of 22-02-2023 to 06-04-2023 from the working days for Semester-4 of her study.
4. To cancel the letters dated 21-02-2023 in regard to above matter.

Agenda-6. To inform that the students of Semester – 2 and Semester – 4 are permitted to continue their B.Ed/M.Ed studies subject to completion of all the work of the Semester afresh which is approved/informed by the Committee:

Resolution-6 The Council took note of the information presented before it.

Agenda-7. To discuss about Admission process for Academic Year 2023-24 and approval of the Executive Council and Academic Council.

Resolution-7 It was decided to take the admission process for Centre of Education courses only from the academic year 2023-24.

Agenda-8. To discuss about implementation of ITEP as per NEP-2020 and approval of the Executive Council and Academic Council.

Resolution-8 It is discussed that in line with the Teacher Education of National Education Policy 2020, it is suggested that by 2030, only educationally sound, multidisciplinary, and integrated teacher education programs shall be in force.

- a. It is necessary that all stand-alone TEIs will be required to convert to multidisciplinary institutions by 2030 since they will have to offer the 4-year integrated teacher preparation program. (**Chapter 15.4 of NEP 2020**)
- b. The 4-year integrated B.Ed. offered by such multidisciplinary HEIs will, by 2030, become the minimal degree qualification for school teachers. (**Chapter 15.5 of NEP 2020**)
- c. The composite institution means a duly recognized higher education institution offering undergraduate or postgraduate programs of study in the field of liberal arts or humanities or social sciences or sciences or commerce, as the case may be, at the time of applying for recognition of teacher education programs. (**2(b) - NCTE Regulation (amended) by the notification dated 04/05/2022**)
- d. Standalone Government colleges conducting Bachelor of Education, desirous of offering an Integrated Teacher Education Programme must do so in collaboration with nearby multidisciplinary Government Higher Education Institutions, which are affiliated with the same university. (**3(f) - NCTE Regulation (amended) by the notification dated 04/05/2022**)

The matter was discussed that it is not possible to convert to multidisciplinary at IITE as suggested in NCTE regulation, as they are standalone colleges. All affiliated colleges of IITE are Grant-in-aid colleges or Government Colleges. These TEIs have the potential to serve teacher education at very nominal fees. The committee took into consideration Ordinance 2 [13-14] of IITE. To follow the NEP 2020, it is decided that all affiliated colleges shall be de-affiliated from IITE and may recommend to the State Government that the affiliation of all these 58 colleges shall be transferred to their regional universities respectively with the recommendations as follows:



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1. Affiliation status of such colleges shall be transferred to the University where previously the college was affiliated before 2020.
2. Simultaneously, the teacher recognition status shall be transferred to the same university.
3. The admission for the academic year 2023 - 2024 may be dealt with by the affiliating university.
4. The students admitted at IITE during the year 2019 - 2022 may continue and finish their studies as per the IITE curriculum and hence the de-affiliation from IITE shall be considered progressive.
5. All such colleges must comply with the liability and pending dues or advances are given to them for the specific task. They shall settle their financial liability or advances with a utilization certificate or as per the direction of the IITE during this progressive period.
6. The teacher recognition at IITE shall be seized from June 2023.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chairman.
