- The title of the Chapter/article should be in capital letters.
- Chapter/article should be in English Or Hindi in MS Word.
- For English language use Times New Roman fonts and for Hindi use Kruti Dev 010 or Mangar or Kokila Font, font size 12, line Spacing 1.5 (A4 size paper).
- The abstract for Book Chapter/article should be from 150-200 words.
- The Chapter/article should be within 2500-3000 words.
- References should be in APA 7th edition format.
- Authors/Contributors are requested to mention their name, designation, experience, institutional affiliation and address, contact no. and email address in the paper.
- There will be no publication charge for authors.
- Authors should give an undertaking that the paper is original with an anti-plagiarism report below 10 percent.
