Agenda - 13 IITE participated in Vibrant Gujarat Global Trade Show 2024 during 9th January 2024 to 13th January 2024. For the participation in VGGTS 2024-

1. iNDEXTB settled our payment of Rs. 6,23,040/- we paid in December 2021 for VGGTS 2022 which was canceled due to Covid pandemic and allotted the stall in Pavilion-11, Stall No. P4, size 50 Sq.mtr
2. As a part of participation in VGGTS 2024, the quotations for stall design and set up were invited from the agencies empaneled with iNDEXTB and the L1 Agency Kamnath Private Limited was assigned the work order for design and installation of stall at VGGTS 2024 for Rs. 4,13,000/- (including GST). The bill from Kamnath Private Limited is yet to receive

The matter is placed before the committee for information and ratification. (UPD Branch)

Resolution - 13 The Council took note of it and ratified the same.

Agenda - 14 In anticipation of the upcoming construction project at the University, specifically the "New Campus Development," the approval of funds for the estimated cost of the "Bhoomi Poojan" and foundation laying program for the new campus, amounting to Rs. 14.00 lakhs is proposed. The agenda is also placed in FC for approval, the matter is placed before the council for ratification and approval. (Estate Branch)

Resolution - 14 The Council ratified the same.

Agenda - 15 The Indian Institute of Teacher Education (IITE) issued a tender for the upgrade and construction of the swimming pool and the creation of a maintenance shed, amounting to Rs. 14,28,150. Following the e-tender opening, an approval of Rs. 16,85,217, exceeding 18%, was granted on 20/10/2022. Subsequently, a letter from IITE dated 24/01/2023 approved an additional Rs. 2,00,649.63 and an extra Rs. 83,552. Additionally, an extension of the work duration from 09/01/2023 to 10/02/2023 was granted based on the architect's review. On 18/03/2023, in accordance with resolution-6 of FC on 15/3/2023, additional work worth Rs. 4,91,640 was incorporated. An extension of 15 days was granted as per the letter dated 18/4/2023. Despite the contractor claiming work completion on 06/05/2023, a meeting and site visit on 27/07/2023 revealed multiple rectifications were required, as suggested by experts, architects, and IITE officials. After the rectifications were completed, an expert inspection on 08/11/2023 and subsequent approval letter on 20 Nov 2023 were obtained. Shri Sunny Patel (Civil Eng) was then invited for bill verification on 21/11/2023. As per their certification, the remaining payment of Rs. 6,03,959 for the approved quantity and non-approved excess and extra work of Rs. 1,06,295 were presented for approval. Additionally, as the contractor completed the work 70 days late, a penalty for those days will be deducted from the proposed bill. The agenda is placed for approval. (Estate Branch)

Resolution - 15 The Council approved the expenses with remarks to deduct the penalty amount for the delayed period.



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- Agenda - 16 The Government has allocated Rs. 2.60 Crore to IITE for repairs and renovation work. Specifically, for terrace repair work, a structural stability check of the existing IITE structure is deemed necessary, as suggested by a civil engineer's observations. To facilitate this, quotations were sought from both the Capital Project Division and SVNIT (Surat) for structural stability tests. The Capital Project Division has provided a rate of Rs. 7,19,800 for the testing, while SVNIT has quoted Rs. 8,50,000/-. Considering the provided rates, the Capital Project Division's rate is the lowest. The agenda is submitted for consideration and approval. (Estate Branch)
- Resolution - 16 The council discussed the urgency of the work and decided to give a work order to that party who will provide the reports on the structural stability check at the earliest. It is decided that the work shall be given to SVNIT (Surat) considering that they will be able to work on an urgent basis.
- Agenda - 17 12th Kalakunj-2023, the annual Youth Festival of Indian Institute of Teacher Education witnessed its 12th edition this year, a vibrant and eagerly anticipated event, unfolded in all its glory on the 19th and 20th of October at the Indian Institute of Teacher Education. The event witnessed the participation of about 1451 participants across various events, from all affiliated colleges and Centre of Education. Total expenditure of the said event is Rs. 26,39,725/-. The matter is put before the council for approval. (SYSW Branch)
- Resolution - 17 The Council appreciated the event of 12th Kalakunj-2023 and approved the total expenditure of Rs. 26,39,725/- for the said event.
- Agenda - 18 12th Josh the annual Sports Meet of Indian Institute of Teacher Education witnessed its 12th edition this year, a youthful and joyous event was held on 1st of January at Sharirik Shikshan Mahavidhyalaya, Sadra Campus of Gujarat Vidhyapith. The event witnessed the participation of 1178 participants in 43 games of various categories. Total expenditure of the said event is Rs 5,35,694/-. The matter is put before the council for approval. (SYSW Branch)

- Agenda - 19 Selection Trials and Participation for various sports events organized during 1-2 November, 2023 for Association of Indian Universities West Zone and National Sports events. 250 students from 22 colleges participated in selection trials During November to February a total of 11 teams of Men and Women category participated in various sports events. Total expenditure for selection trial was Rs. 1,40,000/- and approximate expenditure of participation is Rs. 7,00,000/- (work under progress advance settlement pending). The matter is put before the council for approval. (SYSW Branch)
- Resolution - 19 The Council took note of participation in various sports events by the students and approved the expenditure for it.
- Agenda - 20 UG, PG, and Ph.D. Students of IITE Under Project Based Learning visited and explored two different places, one Statue of Unity and another Vadnagar. The Project Based Learning to Statue of Unity was scheduled on 21st of January 2024 where in total 380 students plus 64 teaching, administrative and non-teaching staff members of IITE went to SoU via Jan Shatabdi Express Train Ahmedabad to Ekta Nagar. The expenditure for the train ticket was Rs.2,16,180/- and food was Rs.1,07,500/- and SoU Viewing Gallery was Rs.1,76,320/-. Later on 28 January 2024 there was PBL organized for the



students who had CTET examination on 21st January 2024 and staff who were not able to accompany on 21st January 2024. In total there were 114 students and 25 teaching, Administrative and non-teaching staff members of IITE who went to Vadnagar and the trip to Vadnagar was done via bus. Two buses of IITE were taken and one bus was hired from GSRTC. The payment of Rs.19000/- was already paid to GSRTC, food expense was Rs.33,600/- and the expense for Museum Ticket and Guide was Rs.4,260/- Total Expense of Rs.5,56,860/-. GSRTC will give 25% concession and also refund the deposit. The process of cancellation of train tickets has been done and it is in the process of calculating the refund amount received. Taking into consideration the final expenditure will be calculated later on. The matter is put for information and approval of the Council. (Centre of Education)
