Rules Related to Unfair Means for Various University Examinations

- 1. Every student enrolled in the University or its constituent institutions shall at all times take reasonable steps to ensure and protect the interest and prestige of the University, pursue his/her studies diligently in accordance with the Statutes, Ordinances, Rules and Regulations of the University, maintain discipline and do nothing which is inappropriate for a "Student", contravention of which shall be treated as misconduct.
- **2.** During the examination, candidates shall be under the disciplinary control of the Center Coordinator of the respective centre.
- 3. On receipt of a report regarding use of unfair means by any student at any University examinations including breach of any of the rules laid down by the University, Disciplinary committee shall inquire into the disciplinary cases referred to it and to punish for such unfair means or breach of the rules by expulsion of such student either for a specified period or permanently, as the case may be, from any University examination or academic programme of study in a recognized Institution or in the University Department or by cancellation of the result of the student in the examination for which the student appeared according to the gravity of the offence.
- 4. Any Act defined as unfair means/ malpractices in Ordinance/Regulation of the University as well as in this document shall be suo moto be considered as unfair means/malpractice.

Any type of unfair means adopted during the examinations that might be of any use for assistance and/or any type of help in answering any question(s) or part of the question thereof as described hereinunder shall lead to the punishment(s) mentioned hereinunder:

If the Vice-Chancellor is convinced that Mass copying there has been a mass copying, or use of unfair particular means at Examination Hall/Centre/Venue, the respective examination may cancelled for all candidates appearing for a particular course/paper and may order for re-examination. **Note:** The Vice-Chancellor will assign the task to Discipline committee to determine and fix the responsibility and to identify the concerned person(s) involved for mass copying. The Vice-Chancellor will be the competent authority for imposing an appropriate penalty upon the responsible person(s) on receipt of recommendation(s) of the Discipline committee. 8. 		The Vice-Chancellor will be a competent authority to decide in such a nature of malpractice.
9.	Tampering with or altering the Statement of Marks/Grades (Mark-sheet or Grade-sheet) and/or Examination registers etc.	The Vice-Chancellor may direct the Registrar to lodge a Police complaint upon receipt of the report from the Discipline Committee and rusticate concerned student(s) from the University, if so warranted.
10.	All other forms of malpractice which are not covered hereinabove.	Appropriate actions would be decided by the Discipline Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.

Abbreviations and Interpretations:

- a) **SPC:** Specific Performance Cancelled (Specificity is about a particular course/paper in which the student is reported for alleged use of Unfair means.)
- b) **CPC:** Current Performance Cancelled (This punishment results into cancellation of entire examination of a semester in which the student is reported for alleged use of Unfair means.)
- c) In case of assignment of any punishment (Except for 1 "WARNING" as listed hereinabove) the student concerned shall be considered to have an "ATTEMPT".
- d) The same set of rules as specified hereinabove shall be applicable even for Supplementary Examinations.
- e) The student shall not be eligible for any medal and/or prize of the University in case of punishment under any of the abovementioned sections, **except 1 wherein WARNING was assigned**.

In all the above listed measures of adopting unfair means, wherein any student appearing for an examination and/or not appearing at any examinations who has been allegedly prima facie reported indulged and found employed in any unfair and unethical act shall be immediately expelled from a course/paper/subject for which he/she is reported. He/She be allowed to appear for all the consequent examination(s) of the same Semester of the respective Programme and/or any other Programme and/or any other examination in which he/she is enrolled as a student.

Further, as all the academic programmes are under the semester system, any student allegedly reported using unfair means at a particular semester be not restricted from studying/admission to the next higher semester, if he/she is found eligible as per rules.

Note:

"Provided that during the pending of an inquiry into the alleged misconduct of a student in an examination, the result of the student shall be kept in reserve. Even if such a result has been inadvertently declared, the University may withdraw/cancel the result even after the declaration. In such case the University shall be competent for asking the mark-sheet back from the concerned student, if any."

Any question arises for the interpretation of these rules; the decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final and binding to all concerned.
