Agenda-1. Request of Zampadiya Nileshbhai Rameshbhai forwarded by DIET Surendranagar regarding continue study in Semester-4:

- Zampadiya Nileshbhai Rameshbhai took the admission in 2021-22 Academic Year and passed Semester-1, 2 and 3 respectively in January-22, May- 2022 and December- 2022 and after completing the internship he left the study as he got the job in Gujarat Police and now he desires to complete the study by taking the leave without pay from his service and he requested to extend the term for his duty.
- As per the Regulation 2021 - 29 of the IITE the normal duration of B.Ed. Degree is 2 year and maximum duration is 4 years. This duration of the course is not included in Regulation – 2023 due to deaffiliation of B.Ed. colleges.

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Agenda is presented for the consideration of the council and allow to use Regulation-2021 in such case.

Agenda-4. Agenda is put forth for deliberation and consideration on the application received for offering of the Tim Tim Tara Life Skill program of Aparajita Foundation under the aegis of Guru Drona Skill Department.

Received a proposal to implement Tim Tim Tara (TTT) life skill program as a skill course, from Ms Krishna Patel, Head, Western Region, Aparajita Foundation. The content of the skill course is defined by the WHO. Ms Krishna Patel has already conducted two workshops on the life skills with B. A. and B.Sc. B.Ed. Students of second semester and she has received very good feedback from the students.

Resolution-4 The council members discussed the proposal and resolved that it should be reviewed. It was further resolved that the possibilities to make a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should also be checked.

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Agenda-5. Agenda is put forth for information on programs organised by COE under its various Cell and Departments.

Following programs were organized.

- 1) Competitive Exam Fees Reimbursement (Dt.26/02/2024): Center of Education reimbursed the competitive examination form filling fees of TAT-II (HS) for 20 students held on 06/08/2023 and TAT-II (HS) Mains on 17/09/2023 and GSET Exam for 84 student held on 26/11/2023. Total 87 students of UG, PG and Ph.D. Programme were reimbursed the fees. The total expenditure incurred was Rs.80,100/-. (Eighty Thousand one hundred only).
- 2) Felicitation Programme for students clearing competitive exams (22 Jan. 2024): Center of Education organised Felicitation Programme on 22nd January 2024 for 87 Students who cleared GSET and NET examination for the year 2023. The total expenditure incurred for the programme was Rs.2,20,952/-
- 3) 5th National Conference on Mathematical Sciences (19-20 February, 2024): Indian Institute of Teacher Education Gandhinagar and Gujarat Ganit Mandal jointly organised 5th National Conference on Mathematical Sciences during 19-20 February, 2024. The aim of the conference was to connect researchers and students of various mathematical science branches on the same platform to enrich the knowledge. The conference witnessed registration from 75 participants, 8 expert talks and 32 paper presentation and in this conference. The total amount received from registration was 97500. The amount received from GGM was 22000. The total expenditure incurred during the of the conference was Rs. 2,55,257/-. (Two Lacs fifty five thousand two hundred and fifty seven ony) Academic output of the conference will come out in the form of E- Book with ISBN number: 978-81-957420-4-2 and Title : Recent Issues on Mathematical Sciences
- 4) 2nd International and National Placement Fair - 2024 by Placement Cell (4 & 5 March 2024): Placement Cell, Center of Education, Indian Institute of Teacher Education organized National and International Placement Fair – 2024. Bhartiya Vidya Bhavans Schools from UAE and Bahrain, 20 schools from Gujarat and two foundations interviewed students for their Placement offers. The total expenditure incurred for the 2nd International and National Placement Fair – 2024 was Rs. 1,43,398/-.
- 5) Student Start-up and Innovation Cell disbursed grant money (15 March 2024): SSIP Cell, Centre of Education, Indian Institute of Teacher Education has approved total 7 Proof of Concept (PoC) proposals of students from Postgraduate M.Sc./M.A. M.Ed. students. Grant money of Rs.1.12 lacs is disbursed for ground breaking and forward-thinking PoC ideas of the students

- 1) Celebration of International Mathematics Day (14 Dec. 2023): Students of Centre of Education and Maths Fun Club celebrated International Mathematics Day on 14-December, 2023 by organization of maths quiz and poster competition online mode. Winner of

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- competition were given prizes, 1st Prize Rs.1000/-, 2nd Prize 750/- and 3rd Prize Rs.500/- and certificates. The total expenditure incurred was Rs.4500/-.(Rs. Four thousand and five hundred only).
- 2) Science Manthan 2024 (17th Feb., 2024) : 24 students of Department of M.Sc./M.A. M.Ed. Programme of Centre of Education participated in Science Manthan – 2024 organised by P. D. Patel Institute Changa, Anand. on 17th February, 2024. The total expenditure incurred was Rs.9,578/- (Rs. Nine Thousand five hundred seventy eight only)
 - 3) Matrabhasha Diwas Celebration (21 Feb.2024) : Center of Education, IITE and Gujarat Council on Science and Technology organised, ' National Mother Language Day' on 21st Feb. 2024. Students and staff participated in the programme. Dr. Parul Patel Former Senior Scientist & Head, RESPOND Program, Space Application Center (SAC), ISRO Pune delivered the Key Note Address on the occasion.
 - 4) Science Day Celebration (28th Feb., 2024): Students of Centre of Education from Department of M.Sc./M.A. M.Ed. Programme celebrated Science Day on 28th February, 2024. The theme of which is Indigenous Technologies for Viksit Bharat 2047. Six competition were held in celebration. The total expenditure incurred was Rs 11740/- (Rs. Eleven thousand seven hundred forty only
 - 5) Women's Day Celebration (13th March 2024): Women Development Cell, Centre of Education in collaboration with Shiksha Swasthya Nyas organized session on, 'Swasthya Mahila – Sashakta Rashtra' as a part of celebration for International Women's Day celebration on 13th March, 2024 at IITE Auditoriyam. Agenda-7. As per the directive of the Education Department, Government of Gujarat, admissions for the academic year 2024-25 are to be conducted for students who have registered with the GCAS portal of the Government of Gujarat. Additionally, the Education Department has issued two circulars outlining the procedures for upcoming admissions, and it is imperative that we adhere to the timeline provided by the department.

The following points require to inform the council:

- The Admission Committee has recommended aligning the admission process with the directives of the Education Department, Government of Gujarat. The minutes of the committee meeting are attached herewith for reference.
- In accordance with the directive from the Education Department, a committee for grievance redressal, document verification, and admission has been formed.
- IITE has consented to adopt the CUET score for both undergraduate and postgraduate admissions. The Admission Committee recommends processing the CUET merit after evaluating the merit of the i3T test conducted by IITE.
- IITE is conducting the Integrated Test for Teacher Trainees (i3T) for undergraduate, postgraduate, and Ph.D. programs. The examination

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centres for conducting the examinations will also be decided accordingly.

Resolution-7 The Council noted the matter and ratified the same after discussion.

Agenda-8. Recognition as Ph.D. Supervisor to teachers of IITE regarding.

The process is going on for recognizing teacher of IITE as research supervisors in Education subject.

Representation have been received from 09 faculties of IITE for recognize them as Research Supervisors in their concerned subject.

Resolution-8 The Council discussed the matter and decided to form a Committee for the case to review the possibility under the objectives of IITE Act/Statute/ Ordinance/UGC Regulations (if any). Teachers with Education Subject shall be given recognition as Research Supervisor as per Ordinances/Regulations. Furthermore, it has been decided that the committee members shall be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor, and the committee's report should be submitted within 10 days to the Vice-Chancellor.
