- 2. Best Teacher Educator


3. Best Teacher Education Institute

Award for Teacher Education

Vision

A teacher is the backbone of any country, and the teachers' teacher is the pivot to nurture this backbone. Honorable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modiji has very rightly said: "If we want to improve the quality of education, the nurturing of teacher is more important as compared to infrastructure and the process of education is more important than the eduction system" IITE is taking up the lead in admiring the efforts in the form of Chanakya award.

About the Awards

Chanakya, also known as Kautilya or Vishnu Gupta was a professor, philosopher, a great scholar and a royal adviser. He spent the last phase of his life at the ancient Takshashila Vidyapith in Takshashila, as a professor of economics and political science. Chanakya served as the chief advisor to Chandragupta. Chanakya has been credited with authoring two treatises said to be the first of its genre in the world – the Arthashastra (Economics), the ancient Indian political treatise; the Nitishastra, the Chanakya Niti, a treatise on the ideal way of life and his policies. He is an apt example of a true Guru and an ideal teacher under whose guidance the Indian Maurya empire emerged as the superpower

in the world and that is why the name of Chanakya is immortal in the history of education in India as well as in the world.

To commemorate and to pay homage to Chanakya, one of the greatest teachers of India, Indian Institute of Teacher Education (IITE) has thought of recognising the efforts with significant and high-quality contributions to the field of teacher education in India by felicitating them with "Chanakya Awards for Teacher Education". Eligibility Criteria

Category 1

- Teacher trainee (i.e. student of any teacher education programme recognised by NCTE,- refer annexure-1) who is in the final year during the awarding year will be eligible.
- Student studying in the last year of teacher training institution in government/grant-in-aid/ unaided/autonomous/constituent institution in India affiliated to a University recognised by UGC may apply.
- In case of nomination, it should be from the Head of the Institution from where he/she is studying.

Category 2

- The teacher educator should have at least ten years of teaching experience in regular service in government / grant-in-aid/ unaided/ autonomous/constituent institution in India affiliated to a University recognised by UGC.
- The teacher educator should be a fulltime teacher as per the UGC guidelines for teacher educator and working in the NCTE recognised TEIs.
- Teacher educator should not be more than 62 years of age as on 1st January of the year of the award.
- In case of nomination, it should be from the Head of the current institution from where he/she is applying.

Category 3

- Any government/grant-inaid/autonomous/constituent/ public/private teacher training institution in India affiliated to a university recognised by UGC and NCTE, having minimum five years' experience of running teacher training programmes may apply.
- The university can also nominate affiliated institute.

Award Guidelines

- 1. Any Indian citizen/institute situated in India can apply.
- Application for the award shall be invited through IITE web- portal or by sending e-mails directly to the state education department, Centre/ State universities and TEIs for wide publicity.
- 3. The detailed instructions is available on the website of IITE, i.e..
- 4. Applicant him/herself can apply directly by filling the application form or external nominator can nominate by filling the nomination form available on the website and submitting it through google link on or before the due date.
- 5. In case of direct application, nomination is not required.
- 6. Application are invited in all the three categories from 10th February, 2025.
- 7. The link of nomination will be shared. In case of nomination, recommendations, for nomination must be submitted in google link on or before 1st March, 2025 The nominated person will be sent mail for further procedure as per norms.
- 8. The last date for application is 31th March, 2025
- 9. Every applicant shall submit self-attested proof of their works (documents, tools, report of activities, field visits, photographs, audios or videos and other supporting materials) in scanned pdf copy along with the application form either in Hindi or in English.

- A recipient of the award cannot be considered for the award again in future for the same category.
- 2. Fill the google form of respective category once only. More than one applications in the same category by the same applicant may lead to disqualify.
- 3. All the supporting documents must be self-attested by the applicant and authenticated by the head of the institute properly.
- 4. IITE reserves the right to consider or reject any submitted nomination /applications without informing the nominee/associated institution.
- 5. Applicant's details will be treated with respect and it will be confidential.
- 6. If a person is nominated, applications from the nominee will be invited within the prescribed due date.
- 7. The decision of IITE in choosing the awardee will be final and cannot be challenged.
- 8. Any kind of changes/modification may be done by IITE without any declaration if deemed necessary.
- 9. By applying for the award, it is considered that the applicant agrees with all the terms and conditions laid down by IITE.
- 10. Any false information submitted in the application form and violation of terms and conditions will lead to immediate & permanent disqualification of the applicant/nominee for the award.
- 11. External pressure or influence for selection may lead to disqualify the application.

- 2. Selection from the eligible applications by selection committee will be done. Selection Committee members may have telephonic/online/offline discussion with applicant/nominees/peers/colleagues/head etc.
- Finalizing the name of awardee by screening committee and if required the finalists will be informed in advance with requirement further to be submitted for the final selection of the awardee.

Award Presentation

- Recipients of the award will be announced felicitated during the function of the foundation day of IITE (30th June) every year.
- 2. Award presentation function will include acceptance deliberation and highlighting contribution of awardee.

- Applicants may be given one task (for instance: preparation of TLM and use it in teaching) and he/she should have to submit the task in stipulated time period in online/offline mode if required.

1.3 Achievements:

- Prize/Rank Certificates in curricular and co-curricular activities (Inter-institutional level will be preferable).
- Any Special achievement/Activity activities (all the supporting documents should be attached).

1.4 Community Contribution: Best five Community Contributions of state Level, National Level or International Level only

Category-3: Chanakya Award for Best Teacher Education Institute

The seven Criteria to serve as the basis for assessment of TEIs are:

1. Curricular Aspects

- 1.1 Planning-Academic calendar, various curricular activity, work load distribution, experts talk on various subjects
- 1.2 Academic Flexibility- implementation of CBCS
- 1.3 Curriculum Enrichment such as "add on Courses" Various additional courses, value-based activities or professional certificates courses

2. Teaching-Learning and Evaluation

- 2.1 Student Enrolment and Profile- Average enrolment percentage
- 2.2 Catering Student Diversity-Gender equality, diversity in various background of students, diversity in kind of enrolment.
- 2.3 Teaching-Learning Process-Various learner centric teaching learning methods, Learning: Participative, team, experimental, collaborative learnings, Teaching: Individual interactive group participative teaching, Mode of teaching learning: Digital, creative, activity based etc, development of learning resources, books handouts E-resources etc.
- 2.4 Competency and Skill Development- Curricular and non-curricular activities which develops various skills, various competitions conducted by Institute to increase competency among the students.
- 2.5 Teachers Profile and Quality of the teachers- Qualification of teacher, special qualification of teacher to help institute any other professional skills of teacher
- 2.6 Evaluation Process- Evaluation process, categorically justified continues internal assessments, kind of various assessment adopted by institute- formative and summative, overall assign task to the students and its follow-up work in CIA, progress report system adopted by institutions

- 2.7 Student Performance and Learning Outcomes- Curriculum objective and learning outcomes and its achievements
- 2.8 Student Satisfaction Survey mechanism Frequency of students' satisfaction survey investigated by institute, feedback of the students will be incorporated by institute, each survey must show strengths and weakness of students

3. Research and Outreach Activities

- 3.1 Resource Mobilization for Research- Administrative management for getting financial support, utilization of received finance, required infrastructure for undertaking research
- 3.2 Research Publications- Research papers and book publication of last five years. ISSN/ISBN will be preferable
- 3.3 Outreach Activities- Awards and recognitions received, outreach programmes conducted
- 3.4 Collaboration and Linkages- Collaboration with any other academic institute, linkage with school or educational institute, training or internship in schools, students or faculty exchange program

4. Infrastructure and Resources

- 4.1 Physical Facilities- Facility of Classroom, Method Rooms, Laboratories, Administrative offices, Staffrooms, Playground, Rest rooms, recreation room, Reading room, Internet access, Canteen / Mess
- 4.2 Library as a Resource Number of Books, Journals and other learning materials. Digital library facility. Number of Text books, Reference books, Handbooks. Student & Teacher Visit ratio in the library.

5. Student Support and Progression

5.1 Student Support- Checklist of students support facility- guidance cell, placement cell, welfare cell, counseling center, grievance and redressal cell, student welfare cell.

- 5.2 Student Progression- Students progression, planning to identify weak students and provision of remedial class to weak students
- 5.3 Student Participation in Activities- Number of participations in various curricular and co-curricular activities, number of students non participations in any activity, yearly calendar for different activity sports, culture events etc.
- 5.4 Alumni Engagement Frequency of organizing Alumni Association Meet, agenda and meeting minutes which cover educational issues raised by alumni students, list of Alumni students with contact number & email address (10 students' Detail)

6. Governance, Leadership and Management

- 6.1 Institutional Vision and Leadership- Vison, Mission and Goals of Institutions, organization chart for academic and administrative
- 6.2 Institutional Development Planning- Institutional development Plan
- 6.3 Empowerment Strategies for Faculty- Faculty appreciable report system adapted by institute, faculty development program conducted by institute, facility/feasibility provided to faculty for enrichment acknowledge, faculty feedback systems
- 6.4 Internal Quality Assurance System (IQAS)- Academic auditing system adopted by the institute, performance measurement systems of academic and administrative staff, promotion scheme of academic and administrative staff

7. Institutional Values and Best Practices

Institutional values and best practices may include:

 Institutional Values and Social Responsibilities- Activity or program organized by institute to confer moral values, organize program on sensitive issues like disaster managements, energy conversation, domestic violence, extension program organized by the institute to help various sector of the society

- Best Practices- Any practice or approach adopted by institute which is unique and innovative in compare to other ordinary institute, any special program or competition conducted by institute for betterment of students or society, any educational services provided by the institute.
- Institutional Distinctiveness- Any specific achievements or award earned by institute to make it distinct or unique in compare with other ordinary institute
