## Guidelines for Poster Presentation

- ▶ The abstract should be concise to 250-300 word summary encompassing the objectives, methodology and major findings, implications of the research.
- ▶ The cover page should contain the paper's title, author(s)' name, designation, institutional affiliation, address, email ID, and contact number of the corresponding authors. It should also specify the theme under which the paper/poster is being submitted.
- ▶ The paper/poster will be accepted in Gujarati, Hindi or English language. Every document will be scrutinized by Experts.

## Criteria for Poster:

- **Title:** Should be clear, descriptive, and easy to read from a distance.
- **Font Size:** Text should be legible from at least 3-5 feet away (e.g., Title: 72 pt, Subheadings: 36-48 pt, Body: 24-36 pt).
- **Visual Appeal:** Balanced use of colors, fonts, and visuals without overcrowding.
- **Sections:** Organized with clear headings (e.g., Introduction, Methodology, Results, Conclusion, and References).
- **Size:** A1 (23.4 x 33.1 inches)

## Presentation Criteria

- **Time Limit:** Presenters may have a set time (e.g., 3-5 minutes) to explain their poster during evaluation.
- **Engagement:** Ability to interact with viewers and answer questions effectively.
- **Knowledge:** Demonstrate a strong understanding of the topic.
- **Communication Skills:** Clarity and confidence during the explanation.

## Best Three Posters:

- The top three posters will be recognized as "Best Posters."
- Each of the three winners will awarded with certificate for best poster presentation.
- Criteria for selecting Best Posters are:
  - ▶ Content and Research Quality
  - ▶ Visual Design and Organization
  - ▶ Presentation and Engagement
  - ▶ Time management, Creativity and Overall Impression
